Clothing Recommendations

- Wear safety vests provided by United Way or brightly colored clothing for visibility.
- Work gloves.
- Work type shoes, boots or sport shoes.

Teams

- Additional groups may be working in your assigned area.
- Youth teams must be accompanied by, and are the responsibility of their youth leader.

Vehicles

- You should have at least one appropriate vehicle (pick-up truck, open trailer, etc.) Two trucks will assist in efficient pick up and delivery of bagged leaves.
- Headlights and flashers should be on at all times.

Helpful Tools

- Snow shovel, broom (to use if the bag breaks)
- Tarp (to cover bagged leaves in transit)

What is the best way to protect your team from traffic?

- Whenever possible, face oncoming traffic while you work.
- Post a reliable lookout person to be aware of traffic situations.
- It is recommended that you pick up one side of the road at a time. Avoid traveling across traffic.

What are the limits of the pickup areas?

- Pick up leaves that are bagged and placed by road.

What should we do in case of emergency?

- Know your location. Call 9-1-1 in an emergency.
- Call 419-674-1721 so that other pick up arrangements can be made if needed.
- Having a first aid kit available is strongly encouraged.
